Spring Warm Up Show

Main Oval, Richmond Park Showgrounds

Float parking in the Stabling area as per Nelson A&P Show (enter through showgrounds main gates and drive SLOWLY through the park past the Grandstands to the stables).

- **NO PLAITING**
- **NO HEIGHT CERTIFICATES REQUIRED** – this is a non-qualifying Show and no wins are to be recorded. Height splits are offered and if the exhibit is deemed to be in the wrong category, may be asked to change class at the request of the Chief Steward. If a previous height certificate measurement is known, this will be considered.
- **Please bring own back number, armband or horse neck number holder**
- This Show/Event supports the RAS "Yellow Card System" AND Clean Sport Rules AND Arrears Policy
- **Entries close Sunday, 29th September (MIDNIGHT) via Evo Events online system.** If you need assistance with this entry & event management computer system please email manager@richmondpark.nz
- Local riders are asked to nominate a volunteer role on their entry. These include helping with set-up, writer/steward, bring-a-plate and helping with breakdown. This nomination can be a non-riding person, or the exhibitor.
- Entries must be paid at closing date.
- **NO LATE ENTRIES OR CLASS CHANGES**
- At close of entries, if there are less than two (2) exhibits entered in the classes/sections, Nelson A&P Association may choose to amalgamate classes/sections as necessary.
- Riders must wear a helmet. Helmets do not need to be tagged, but must have at least 3 point safety harness, fit well & be in good condition. Riding boots with a smooth heel must be worn. Closed toe sturdy footwear must be worn in hand.
- The judge's decision is final, and no protests will be entered into.
- Competitors may enter more than one ring, but classes will not be held.
- Novice is a horse/pony that has not won 6 firsts at an A & P show.
- Ridden exhibits to be 4 years and over, age is as of 1st August for horses & riders.
- Appropriately sized Adults can ride ponies in all Classes.
- Refunds require a vet or medical certificate to be presented within 7 days of the event.
- Class entry fee: \$5.00 per class
- Administration fee \$10 per exhibitor (unlimited number of horses)
- EvoEvents online entry fee \$0.55 per class
- Champion & Reserve Sashes
- Ribbons 1st – 4th.

Riders not to be younger than 4 years old, up to and including 7 years old
