Exhibits should be clearly labelled with style, specialty or unusual ingredients.

Exhibit labels supplied by the A&P Office

should be attached approximately half-way up the bottles.

More than one bottle per class can be entered providing it is of a different batch.

DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS: All exhibits are to be delivered to Scout Hall between **9:00am and 1:00pm Wednesday 18th November** or they may be left at the main office prior to this date.

Office will also be open Saturday 14th November 10am-12pm

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

All exhibits are to be shown in 750ml or 375ml clear shouldered with straight neck wine bottles with screw caps or cork tops. If corked, must be flange type. Screw caps must be black. Ribbed plastic stoppers may be used only with champagne bottles. Exhibits should be clearly described with main ingredients on the entry form. Exhibit labels supplied by the A&P Office should be attached approximately half-way up the bottles.

More than one bottle per class can be entered providing it is of a different vintage or batch. A Wine made from a blend of ingredients should be entered in a class relating to the dominant ingredient or flavour.

Classes 7121 & 7122 must be in champagne bottles. Classes 7104 & 7105 for wine from apples/pears/quinces. Classes 7110 & 7111 for wine from any small berries excluding boysenberries. All boysenberry dominant wines should be entered in 7115.

Recommended fill height (ullage) 30mm

Novice classes (7126, 7127) are for competitors who have not won a prize previously in the Wine Section of the Nelson A&P Show.
