ENTRIES CLOSE: Friday 6th November. No late entries will be accepted.

VENUE: Waimea Grandstand

ENTRY FEES: A&P Members Free, Non Members \$15 per person (includes one day gate entry ticket)

DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS: No later than 5pm Friday 6th November to Nelson A & P office at the Richmond Showgrounds.

Conditions of Entry

1. This competition is open to everyone except competition judge(s) and their immediate family.
2. Please take care to enter your image in the correct class. Entries must be appropriate to the title of the class entered. (Please give photos a title for easier identification).
3. The exposure of the image must be the original work of the entrant.
4. No AI generated images will be accepted.
5. Prints may be trade processed and may be digitally enhanced.
6. No watermarks on photos allowed.
7. A maximum of five (5) entries per class is allowed.
8. Entries are to be 6" x 4" prints and must be mounted on black card, the border no greater than 5cm past the edge of the photo. (Please note in 2026 5"x7" are no longer be accepted)
9. Class and title name, address, phone number, corresponding to the entry form must be printed clearly **on the back** of the image, top centre.
10. An image may be entered once only in either Adults, Children's or Horticultural sections, not multiple.
11. All rules listed here also apply to the Garden Photos Classes in the Horticultural section.
12. No entry that has previously won a ribbon at the Nelson A & P Show is eligible for entry.
13. Images must be suitable for viewing by the general public, any images that portray objectionable scenes will not be accepted. Old, marked or dirty images and / or mounts will not be accepted.
14. ***Entries that do not meet these conditions will be disqualified. Entry fees are not refundable.***
15. Exhibitors requiring their entries to be returned by mail or Courier must include return postage or courier tickets/bags with their entries.
16. The utmost care will be taken by the organisers but the A & P Association do not accept any responsibility for damage to exhibits while in their possession.
17. Photos and Ribbons can be collected from 3.30pm Sunday 22nd November and from Tuesday after the show from the A&P Office.
18. Entrants can only enter either Open or Novice (not both).
19. Novice classes are for competitors who have not entered previously in the photography section of the Nelson A&P Show or is not a competent photographer. (Entries in this section must not be entered into any other class)
