

- This Show/Event supports the RAS 'In-Line Resolution Process' Policy AND Clean Sport Rules AND Arrears Policy
- Entries Close: Monday 5pm, November 11th 2024
- Entries MUST be entered under the name of the owner of the animal or lessee name if the lease has been registered with the RAS.
- After close of entries, if there are less than five (5) animals and/or three (3) exhibitors entered in the classes/sections, Nelson A&P Association may choose to amalgamate classes/sections as necessary.
- Entry Fees must be paid at close of entries. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Equestrian Administration team.
- Class changes and substitutions are at the discretion of the Equestrian Administration team unless a Vet Certificate is provided.
- No credit refunds will be given for class changes & substitutions made in the week before the Show.
- In the event that a horse is scratched a refund of all fees will be given minus the Equestrian & Admin Levy & the cost of any tickets issued if a Vet Certificate is provided.
- No Class will be held for late entrants or those that have entered multiple rings.

- RAS Height Certificates are not required for the Inhand Section, unless classes are defined by height.
